THE MAKE IN INDIA

- The Make in India initiative aims to transform India into a global manufacturing hub. It focuses on increasing domestic production, creating employment opportunities, and encouraging investment in the country.
- The Make in India programme was launched to provide the necessary infrastructure, improve the ease of doing business, and develop skilled human resources required for India's growth.
- Several sectors such as information technology, defence production, aviation, railways, automobiles and auto components, pharmaceuticals, renewable energy, mobile manufacturing, and textiles have shown significant progress under this initiative.
- With the objective of making India a global centre for production, design, and innovation, the "Make in India" initiative was launched on 25 September 2014.
- The programme focuses on: Simplifying procedures, Encouraging foreign investment, Creating world-class infrastructure, Improving the quality of products to meet global standards.
- Based on the principle of "Minimum Government, Maximum Governance," various steps and policy measures have been implemented under this initiative to reform existing practices and improve the business environment.
- As the next phase, the "Make in India 2.0" initiative was introduced to expand and strengthen the programme further.
- Currently, a total of 27 sectors are covered under the initiative, including 15 manufacturing sectors and 12 service sectors.
