OSIRIS-REx Space mission

Collection of samples

- Asteroid Bennu It is 200 million kilometers from Earth
- Success in collecting rock and soil samples by NASA OSIRIS-REx

Asteroids in the Solar System

Planets

Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars

Asteroids

- It revolves around the Sun in an elliptical path
- According to the study so far, 1.31 lakh asteroids
- Diameter 1 m to 1000 m

Bennu

- Danger of Asteroid Hitting Earth, Scientists warn
- Bennu Could hit Earth in 300 years

Origin

- 450 million years ago
- Before of the origin of the Earth

Need to study Bennu

- Origin of the solar system
- Origin of Planets
- Origin of living things and water

OSIRIS-REX

- Launched on September 8, 2016 towards Bennu
- Reached Bennu on December 3, 2018
- Collected samples on Oct 20, 2020 Sand and Rocks
- Journey towards Earth started on May 10, 2021
- Container 44,500 km speed
- In the 13th minute after entering the Earth's atmosphere, it fell in the desert of the state of Utah, USA

Important note

- 1999 found by linear analysis
- Name given by scientists 1999 RQ36
- 9 year student Bennu

Chip manufacturing

Chip factory in India

- Development in new technology - Artificial Intelligence, 5G and Internet of Things
- India Strong intellectual hub and growing demand
- India 20% of semiconductor design engineers worldwide

Govt initiative

- 2021 Design Linked Incentive Scheme
- Providing incentives to domestic design firms
- Goal Innovation should be domestically focused
- 20 companies should be created which can earn more than 1500 crore rupees
- Domestic chip manufacturing companies to operate with equal share
- Ensuring a sustainable ecosystem by promoting sustainable enterprises
- The semiconductor industry is capital intensive
- A long-term strategic policy is essential
- The Government's efforts are ineffective and inefficient
- Equity infusion Local, small and medium enterprises will be encouraged

Challenges

- Fewer venture capitalists
- Low annual income
- High cost of design
- High volume production period

- A confederation of three major democracies and three major economies from three different continents
- Negotiating method Facilitating communication
- Consequence South-South Confederation

Goal

- Increasing trade opportunities between the three countries
- Information, technology and skills transfer

Formation

- June 06, 2023 Meeting of Foreign Ministers held in Brasilia, Brazil
- The forum does not have a permanent secretariat

IBSA Forum

- Discuss and work together on global and regional political issues
- Building partnerships and people-to-people collaboration through functional grouping in sustainable areas
- Funding in this forum is in aid of projects in developing countries

Components

- IBSA Trust fund
- Formed in 2004
- India, Brazil, South Africa

Implementation in 2006

- Goal Alleviating poverty and hunger in developing countries
- Supporting development projects of the South, Southern Federation
- 44 million USD allocation
- Supports 39 development projects of 34 member countries

IBSA MAR

- Multinational Naval Training
- Goal Building a strong alliance in naval defense
- 7th Edition Port Elizabeth, South Africa Oct 10-12, 2022

IBSA Cooperative Scheme

- Goal Encouraging exchange of young researchers in economic and social science fields
- Effect Strengthening research collaborations between IBSA in the South

The Women's Reservation Bill was passed

33% reservation

- Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam
- Success in 5th attempt
- 1996 Deve Gowda govt
- Introduced in Lok Sabha
- Dissolution of 11th lok sabha. The bill has lapsed
- 81st Amendment Bill
- 1998 Dec 14 Vajpayee govt
- Introduced in Lok Sabha
- Dissolution of 12th lok sabha. The bill has lapsed
- 84th Amendment Bill
- 1999 Dec 23 Vajpayee govt
- Introduced in Lok Sabha
- The bill was not carried forward due to lack of consensus
- 85thAmendment Bill
- 2008 Man Mohan Singh Govt
- Introduced in Rajya Sabha
- Passed in 2010
- 108thAmendment Bill
- Dissolution of Lok Sabha & not passed. The bill has lapsed

- Total 542
- Women 81 (14.39%)
- The national average of women legislators is 9%.
