



What does international law say about embassies?

- Under the Vienna Convention, foreign embassies are individually sovereign.
- Law enforcement officers cannot enter an embassy in one country without the permission of the ambassador.
- It is worth recalling that Ecuador, which has now actively entered the Mexican Embassy, ??sheltered WikiLeaks founder Jullian Assange for 7 years in their embassy in London, the British capital.
- Due to this, the British police could not re-arrest him who was out on conditional bail in the sex case.
- British police arrested Assange in 2019 after Ecuador finally gave permission.
